Controls trade with other countries

Executive



Oversees departments and agencies

Judicial



Serve for life

The Court System

Commander-in-Chief of the military

The lawmaking branch

Can VETO a bill.

Nominates judges for the Supreme Court

Coin and print money

Can declare war

Can rule that a president's actions are unconstitutional

Raise an army and a navy

Can rule that a law is unconstitutional

Can override a president's VETO with a 2/3 majority vote.

Enforces the law

Decide if laws are working fairly.

Approves judges that are nominated to the Supreme Court.

Serves for a four year term

Can serve two year terms in the house of Representatives and a six year term in the Senate.
